

It is important to note that for newly confirmed cases results of samples were recorded twenty-four (24) to forty-eight (48) hours after the swabbing date.

It is noteworthy to mention that a data cleaning exercise was performed on the total confirmed cases by islands. It was discovered that some cases were from the island of New Providence and not from the Family Island previously indicated. Hence four (4) cases have been subtracted from the islands with an asterick (\*) and added to total confirmed cases for New Providence.
