** IMPORTANT NOTES

The Ministry of Health also advises that the total number of newly confirmed cases do not represent the number of confirmed cases for the past 24 - 48 hours. Instead this number also takes into account seven (7) additional unreported cases between 25^{th} March and 10^{th} May, 2021.

REMINDERS

To contain the spread of COVID-19 residents are reminded of the following:

- if you have symptoms of COVID-19, do not wait, first contact your health provider.
- while home remedies may work for a period it is important to get tested and receive proper care before symptoms become too difficult to manage.
- if you have been asked by the Surveillance Unit to get tested for COVID-19, please follow the advice and take the gold standard RT-PCR test.
- employees are encouraged to work from home.
