This document defines the scope of work and technical specifications required for: **Proposed renovations for Ministry of Health National Reference Laboratory, New Providence**. The Project Owner will be the Ministry of Health and Wellness with its Project Executing Unit providing project development and project management support as the Contracting Agency.

Subject to the specifications herein, the Project scope includes the Renovation of an existing two storey office building to a Reference Laboratory and associated administrative offices. Inclusive accessibility upgrades, HVAC upgrades and the addition of an elevator.

This procurement process will be conducted in accordance with the Policies for Procurement of Goods and Works financed by the Inter-American Development Bank GN-2349-15 January 2020. This document will be published on the Government of The Bahamas' eProcurement website <a href="mailto:bahamas.bonfirehub.com">bahamas.bonfirehub.com</a> to facilitate bidders' participation. All requests for clarification of this RFB are to be submitted as a message within this request for bids via the eProcurement website.

The contract will be awarded to the Bidder whose Bid has been determined to be substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents, and represents the lowest evaluated cost, provided that such Bidder has been determined to be eligible in accordance with the Inter-American Development Bank provisions.
