## **PREFACE**

This publication presents data on the value and volume of trade between The Bahamas and the rest of the world. It contains a five year series of summary data to provide an historical view of trade for The Bahamas during that period. Detailed tables (both annual and quarterly) of the year 2011 are presented in order to provide an in depth view of trade for that year.

Reports on trade statistics for The Bahamas have been published since 1968 and have undergone many revisions in both the format of the report and the methodology of the compilation of the figures. Initially, trade statistics were compiled using the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC), which classifies commodities by two criteria (1) the material of which the commodity has been made and (2) how the commodity will be used. This classification, subjected to periodic revisions, is still used today, though not predominantly.

The Harmonized System (HS) was adopted by the Customs Co-operation Council in June 1983 and enforced by the HS Convention in 1988. In 1993, the Statistical Commission, at its 27<sup>th</sup> session recommended that countries adopt the HS for the compilation and dissemination of their international trade statistics. In The Bahamas, however, the Customs Department did not implement the HS until July 1996 and the Department of Statistics followed suit in January, 1997. Since its implementation, the HS has been regularly revised, the latest having occurred in 2007. However, the 2007 revisions were not reflected in the 2007 figures/report as the changes did not take effect until July, 2008. As a result the figures in this 2011 report are reflective of the 2007 revisions of the HS code.

The data in this report are collected by the Bahamas Customs Department and are forwarded to the Department of Statistics where they are processed, analyzed and published. Both the SITC and the HS system of commodity classification are used in the presentation of the data.

## **Data Notes and Explanation**

### **1. Data Source**

The source documents of the statistics in this report are the Customs import entries, declarations and export documents submitted by importers and exporters, which are subject to verification and approval by The Bahamas Customs Department.

### **2. Coverage**

As recommended by the United Nations International 'Merchandise Trade Statistics Manual', and to the extent possible, the General Trade System is used for the recording and compilation of external trade statistics for The Bahamas. This system covers all types of inward and outward movement of goods through a country or territory, including movements through warehouses and free zones. In essence, it includes all merchandise that either add to or reduce the stock of material resources of a country or territory by entering (imports) or leaving (exports) the country's economic territory.

### **3. Transaction Values**

The value of imports are c.i.f., that is, the value at the port of importation including freight and insurance charges and other charges incidental to the delivery at the port of import.

The values of exports are f.o.b., that is, the value of goods including the cost of transportation and insurance to the border of the exporting country.

The values presented are Bahamian dollars and the exchange rates prevailing at the time of importation are used in converting foreign currencies.

### **4. Changes/Exclusion to Presentation of Trade Data**

Excluded from the compilation of the foreign trade statistics are the goods traded that do not make any changes to the wealth and material resources of the country. Examples of such goods are crude oil, residual fuel oils and certain chemicals temporarily imported for storage purposes only.

## **5. Commodity Classification**

The classification of goods used in this report is the Harmonized Description and Coding System, better known as the Harmonized System (HS) and the Standard International Trade Classification (SITC). The HS arranges goods according to their degree of manufacture and classifies them into ninety-seven chapters which are grouped into twenty-one sections. Section twenty-two was added to accommodate local trade. The SITC on the other hand, arranges goods according to their stage of production. The SITC contains sixty-seven divisions which are condensed into ten sections.

### **Definitions and Abbreviations:**

**Imports** – Goods imported from foreign countries for further processing or local consumption.

**Domestic Exports** – Goods produced or manufactured locally and exported to foreign countries.

**Re-exports** – goods exported in the same condition as when imported from a foreign country

**Balance of Trade** – is the total export minus the total import. It is usually calculated totally for a country or for each trading partner.

**Port of Entry** – a port that serves as a first port of entry from an international port.

## 2011 Annual Trade Data Highlights

Data on merchandise trade for the year 2011 shows that the value of commodities imported into The Bahamas totaled some \$3.4 billion dollars resulting in a significant increase of 19.1% above 2010's total of \$2.9 billion.

**'Mineral Fuels'** the largest contributor to goods imported for 2011 totaled some 930 million dollars in comparison to 2010 which was \$687 million. That is it accounted for 27.3% of the total imports. **'Machinery and Transport Equipment'** the second major category totaled \$583.2 million (or 17.1% of all imports). This category showed an increase of 18% between 2010 and 2011. (**Chart 1**)

The **'Food and Live Animals'** category (fresh meats, fruits & vegetables and processed foods) which is the third major category accounted for over \$463.5 million (14% of total imports) (**Chart 1**).

The commodities which contributed mainly to total imports were **'Other Diesel'** valued at \$387.8 million, **'Motor Gasoline'** at \$221.7 million, **'Other Fuel Oil'** valued at 176.7, and **'Jet Fuel'** at \$84.3 million. The combined value of these commodities represented 26% of total imports (**Table i**).

Total exports (domestic and re-exports) totaled \$726.9 million representing an increase of 17% in 2011. Domestic exports (\$326.4 million) accounted for about 45% of total exports. The main contributors to domestic exports were the categories of **'Chemicals'** totaling \$210.8 million (65% of total domestic exports), **'Food and Live Animals'** totaling \$75.5 million (23% of total domestic exports), and **'Crude Minerals'** totaling 32.2 million (10% of total domestic exports) (**Table 2.3**). **'Chemicals'** showed an increase of 13% over 2010. Three commodities alone, 'expansible polystyrene' valued at \$133.5 million, 'other compounds containing a pyrimidine ring' at \$73.8 million and 'spiny lobster frozen' at \$64.3 million accounted for some 83.2% of total domestic exports (**Table ii**).

The balance of trade (total exports minus total imports) continued to result in a deficit. However, the trade balance between 2009 and 2010 showed an increase of 6% resulting in a net trade balance of -\$2.2billion dollars compared to -\$2.1billion in 2009. The percentage increase in the trade balance between 2010 and 2011 more than tripled from 6% in 2009/2010 to 19.7% in 2010/2011.

## **Main Trading Partners**

While there was a significant volume of trade as it relates to imports between The Bahamas and Puerto Rico (\$235.6 million) and Trinidad and Tobago (\$159.1 million), the United States (\$2.8 billion) represented 82% of total imports, and about 78% of total exports as the Bahamas' principal trading partner. In terms of exports the United States (\$567 million), France (\$26.3 million) and United Kingdom (\$32 million) were among the top partner countries, representing 78%, 3.6% and 4% of total exports, respectively.

Trade between The Bahamas and Caricom countries was minimal as the region represented only 5% of total imports and less than 1% of total exports. Oil products imported from Trinidad and Tobago and valued at nearly \$ 158 million accounted for 95% of total imports from the region. **Pharmaceutical Products** imported from Barbados and valued at \$2.2 million (2% of Caricom imports) were also among the major imports from the region.

Sea Salt (valued at \$900 thousand) exported to Jamaica represented 55% of total exports to the region.



### Value of Imports by Section of Commodity: 2011




**Value of Exports by Section of Commodity: 2011**




