Users of this information will find it a meaningful addition to the usual body of information for planning and decision-making.

The data has been structured on the basis of the 1993 Revised United Nations System of National Accounts. Abbreviated definitions of the basic aggregates and an outline of the methodology employed to derive the data are also included. Persons interested in the details of the sources and methods of the estimates are advised to contact the National Accounts Section.

CONCEPTS & DEFINITIONS

The System of National Accounts (SNA): SNA 1993 consists of a coherent, consistent integrated set of macroeconomic accounts; balance sheets and tables based on a set of internationally agreed concepts, definitions, classifications and accounting rules. It provides a comprehensive accounting framework within which economic data can be compiled and presented in a format that is designed for purposes of economic analysis, decision-taking and policy-making.

The Supply and Use Tables (SUT): The central framework of the SNA 1993 contains detailed Supply and Use tables in the form of matrices that record how supplies of different kinds of goods and services originate from domestic industries and imports and how those supplies are allocated between various intermediate or final uses, including exports. These tables involve the compilation of a set of integrated production and generation of income accounts for industries – that is, groups of establishments as distinct from institutional units – that are able to draw upon detailed data from industrial censuses or surveys. The Supply and Use tables provide an accounting framework within which the commodity flow method of compiling national accounts – in which the total supplies and uses of individual types of goods and services have to be balanced with each other – can be systematically exploited. The Supply and Use tables also provide the basic information for the derivation of detailed input-output tables that are extensively used for purposes of economic analysis and projections.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP): This is the sum of the remuneration of all Bahamian factors of production - labor, capital and land - employed in the creation of the unduplicated total output of the Bahamian economy in the Bahamas. It also includes net indirect taxes i.e. indirect taxes less subsidies. When such net indirect taxes are excluded from the total, it is known as GDP at factor cost.

Gross National Product (GNP): either at market prices or factor cost differs from the domestic product by including the income of Bahamian capital earned abroad and excluding the contribution of foreign capital to the Bahamian economy. These contributions are represented by interest and dividend receipts and payments to and from abroad.

Gross Value Added (GVA): is defined as output (at producer's prices) less intermediate consumption (at purchaser's price) for the industries making up the GDP. The difference between gross and net value added and gross and net operating surplus is depreciation. The industrial composition of GDP follows the International Standard Industrial Classification Revision 4 (ISIC Rev.4).

Expenditure on Gross Domestic Product: Also referred to as Gross Domestic Expenditure (GDE) - constitutes all Final Expenditures by Households and Government; Investments; Exports minus Imports. Final expenditure is defined as expenditure that is not used up in the production process within the year. The differences between Gross Domestic Expenditure and Gross National Expenditure, is identical to the difference between GDP and GNP.

SOURCES AND METHODS

A: GROSS VALUE ADDED BY INDUSTRIAL ORIGIN:

Production Approach:

The economy is divided into industries such as Manufacturing, Electricity, and Construction etc., based on the International Standard Industrial Classification Revision 4. The measure is Gross Value Added which is calculated as Revenue/Sales at Producers Prices minus Cost of Goods Sold and Intermediate Consumption, plus Other Net Indirect Taxes less Dummy Financial Corporations (FISIM).

The data is sourced from most industries through surveys conducted by the Department of Statistics' (DOS) Business Establishment Section. The largest entities in the various industries are censured, while for the smaller entities a scientifically constructed sample survey is used. The data derived from questionnaires are items such as gross revenue, wages and salaries, detailed expenses incurred in carrying out the business, depreciation etc.

Information gathered from those industries not surveyed, is normally available either from administrative records or are collected by pertinent government or quasi-government agencies. These include the Ministry of Agriculture and the Department of Fisheries, which provide agriculture and fisheries data respectively. The Financial Industry data is obtained mainly from the Insurance Commission of The Bahamas and the Central Bank of the Bahamas. Information for Public Administration, Public Education and Public Health comes from the Ministry of Finance and the Central Bank of the Bahamas.

B: EXPENDITURE ON GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT:

Expenditure Approach:

This approach divides the economy into the consumption of Government and Households, Investment and Exports of goods & services minus Imports of goods & services. The resulting figure is the same value of GDP as obtained by the Production Approach.

<u>Government Final Consumption Expenditure</u> is derived from an analysis of current expenditure details from the Ministry of Finance and the Bahamas's Central Bank.

Private Final Consumption Expenditure of Residents has many elements. This is derived primarily from the Household Expenditure Survey 2006 results which were used in the calculation of the 2007 SUT. The years prior to and beyond 2007 are moved with data collected and estimated from other surveys. A major part of the PFCE total in these years is derived from the establishment survey results. This consists of revenue in retail trade - adjusted for sales made for purposes of Gross Fixed Capital Formation and sales made to other businesses. The revenues of hotels, restaurants, service establishments, medical, educational and professional services, as well as the expenditure of charitable organizations and associations of individuals such as labor unions are all included. Gross Rent paid and imputed residential rents for household accommodation is derived mainly from the census of population and labor force surveys. Paid and imputed service charges for personal banking and insurance services are also included. An estimate for expenditure in the informal economy is also made.

<u>The Change in Stocks</u> is obtained from records of public corporations and the establishment surveys of retail and wholesale trade. At present, no complete knowledge of inventory accounting practices exists nor are there any price indices measuring the change in the value of inventories, these estimates must be considered rough approximations to the true change in the value of inventories. Presently no data exist in areas other than outlined above.

The values of <u>Residential Building Construction</u> and of <u>Other Construction</u> are based on the establishment surveys in the construction industry and information from the Balance of Payments. Purchases of <u>Machinery and Equipment</u> are derived from detailed Import data adjusted for custom duties and mark-ups.

The values of <u>Exports and Imports of Goods and Services</u> are anchored to the Balance of Trade and the Balance of Payment data estimated by the Department of Statistics and the Central Bank of the Bahamas respectively. The Tourism data is based on the Ministry of Tourism estimates.

USES OF NATIONAL ACCOUNTS²

- 1. <u>Monitoring the behavior of the economy</u> by comparing and following the movement of economic flows such as production, household consumption, government consumption, capital formation, exports, imports etc.
- 2. <u>Macro-economic analysis</u> using econometric models to investigate the casual, functional relationships between different economic variables.
- 3. <u>Economic policy making and decision-taking</u> short term policy can be made based on recent behavior and the current state of the economy and a view or precise forecast about likely future developments.
- 4. <u>Harmonization between different statistical systems</u> by promoting consistency in terms of concepts, definitions and classifications. Revisions of these various systems are conducted in parallel with the SNA.
- 5. <u>International Comparison</u> which normally compare GDP or GDP per head, ratio's of investment, taxes or government expenditure on GDP. These are used to evaluate the performance of similar economies, eligibility for loans, aid or other funds or conditions on which such loans, aid or funds are made available. It also determines the size of the contributions which member countries of international organizations make to finance operations of these organizations.

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
DATA HIGHLIGHTS

The National Accounts Section of the Department of Statistics announces the release of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the period 2011 to 2015. The 2015 figures are Preliminary, 2014 are Provisional, 2013 and 2012 are Revised and the 2011 is Final until the next historical revision.

The 2015 annual preliminary results are based on early estimates from major data sources such as the Central Bank, Ministry of Tourism, the Foreign Trade Section of the Department of Statistics, and many others. They are also based on indicators such as Hotel Room Rates, Megawatt Sales, Building Permits, Chargeable Telephone Minutes, Consumer Price Index, etc., which normally mimic movements of particular industries. The 2015 GDP figures are Preliminary and will be revised as more data become available.

The GDP is measured in both Current Market Prices and Constant 2006 Prices. The current measure utilizes current price levels and currency values, factoring in inflation and determines the total value of the products and services produced in a particular year. The Constant Prices takes into account the impact of inflation and is more useful for studying trends in economic growth.³

According to the preliminary results, the GDP in Current Prices for 2015 had a positive growth of 2.74% however, GDP in Constant Prices decreased by 1.66%.



The decline at constant prices was due mainly to decreases in the Construction, Hotel, Mining, Manufacturing Industries and Financial Services Directly Measured (FISIM). In contrast, the Wholesale & Retail Trade, Banking, Real Estate, Business Services and Public Administration & Defense Industries displayed positive growth, which mitigated the size of the decrease.

The Expenditure Approach to GDP divides the economy into Sectors and yields the same level of GDP as dividing it into industries. The Sectors are measured as Government and Household Final Consumption Expenditure plus Investments and Exports of Goods and Services minus Imports of Goods and Services.


The Exports of Goods and Services at Current Prices experienced a decrease of 6.6% in 2015 compared to 2014. The negative impact in 2015 was as a result of an approximate 35.8% decrease in Exports of Goods, especially Mineral Fuels & Mineral Oils etc. (\$95 million) and Chemicals & Related Products (\$110.7 million). There was also a drop in the Local Expenses of the Off-Shore Companies of 8.3% as they reduced the level of spending on operating inputs. The Exports of Goods and Services at Constant Prices, when deflated by a Combined Goods and Services Index, which moved from 98.8 in 2014 to 99.4 in 2015, also showed a significant decrease of 7.2%.

The Imports of Goods and Services typically have a dampening effect on the level of GDP, as it is always deducted from the overall value, therefore any significant changes in these figures, will have a noticeable impact on the level of GDP.

The continuing decrease in the world price per barrel of crude oil from \$54.14 (December 30th, 2014) to \$37.13 (December 31st, 2015) had a significant impact on the value of Imports and local businesses overall operating cost, as they experienced a reduction in the cost of electricity.

In 2015, the Imports of Goods, which usually account for approximately 70+% of all Imports, fell by 16.6% in Current Prices. This decline was led mainly by decreases in the Import of Mineral Products of \$333.2 million or 38.4%; Articles of Iron or Steel of \$43.1 million or 32.3%; Machinery Equipment \$59.6 million or 12.2% and Optical Photographic & Measuring apparatus etc. of \$40.9 million or 59.5%.


The Imports of Services at Current Prices decreased by 31.8% led by Construction Services Imported, which fell by 64.9% or \$417.3 million. The reduced spending on construction during 2015 had a significant effect on the Imports as well as the Construction Industry as a whole.



Gross Capital Formation measures the value of Investment in Buildings, Machinery and Infrastructure in the economy and is a combination of the materials and labour that are utilized to produce the various projects.

The Gross Capital Formation in Current Prices fell by 10.4% compared to 2014. The Gross Capital Formation in Constant Prices fell by 11.9%. The main contributor to this decrease was that of the Non-Residential Construction which fell by 42.1% or \$293.3 million, driven by the aforementioned decline in the level of Construction Services Imported. However, Residential Construction also had an impact, growing by \$26.1 million or 15.4%. The Machinery and Transport Equipment which normally represent on average 43+% of Gross Capital Formation had a slight decrease of \$7 million or 0.1%.

The Private Final Consumption Expenditure (PFCE) or Household Expenditure which on average accounts for 70% of the GDP, decreased in Current Prices by 7% and in Constant Prices by 6.5%. The decreased household expenditure was partly the result of a high Unemployment Rate of 14.8%, which resulted in a downward pressure on wages.



The Government Final Consumption Expenditure (GFCE) is measured as Compensation of Employees, Depreciation Expense and Intermediate Consumption. This figure is split between Individual Consumption and Collective Consumption. In 2015, The Individual Consumption, which includes items such as Health and Education expenditure, grew by 3.5% at Constant Prices and the Collective Consumption, which represents the remaining services, experienced a 9.2% growth.
