MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS ACT (NO. 50 OF 2014)

MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS (VISAS) REGULATIONS, 2015

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Act (No. 50 of 2014), makes the following Regulations —

1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Visas) Regulations, 2015.

2. Interpretation.

- (1) In these Regulations
 - "Act" means the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Act (No. 50 of 2014);
 - "Minister" means the Minister responsible for Foreign Affairs;
 - "visa" means an authenticating endorsement issued by or on behalf of the Minister and placed in a passport or travel document which has been examined by a consular officer of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and endorses that the holder of the passport or travel document has met the requirements and is permitted to travel to The Bahamas.
- (2) A visa does not guarantee the right of entry into The Bahamas which right is subject to the requirements of the Immigration Act.

3. Issuance of visas.

- (1) The Minister may in accordance with these Regulations issue visas for the entry into The Bahamas of persons who are not citizens or permanent residents of The Bahamas.
- (2) The Minister may issue the categories and types of visas, for the periods of validity, as are specified in the *First Schedule*.
- (3) The Minister may authorize and designate in writing a consular officer to exercise the authority of the Minister to issue visas under these Regulations.

4. Person required to have a visa.

A person who, not being a citizen or permanent resident of The Bahamas, wishes to visit The Bahamas must apply to the Minister for a visa where that person —

- (a) is a citizen of a country designated in the Second Schedule; or
- (b) is a citizen of any other country and that person wishes to visit The Bahamas for educational or employment purposes.

5. Application for visa.

An application for a visa must be —

- (a) made in the Form set out in the *Third Schedule*:
- (b) submitted in completed Form to the Minister, or a consular officer, and accompanied by
 - (i) the documents and information necessary to complete the prescribed Form; and
 - (ii) the applicable fee.

6. Grant and refusal of application.

- (1) The Minister, or a consular officer acting on the Minister's behalf, may grant or refuse an application for the issuance of a visa made pursuant to regulation 5.
- (2) Where an application for issuance of a visa is refused
 - (a) the applicant shall be informed of the reason for the refusal in any case where the Visa Denial Codes listed in the *Fourth Schedule* apply; and
 - (b) the application may not be re-submitted until the expiry of three months after the date of the refusal.

7. Review on refusal of application.

- (1) A person aggrieved by a decision of a consular officer to refuse an application for issuance of a visa has the right to have the decision reviewed by the Minister in accordance with paragraph (2).
- (2) An application for a review by the Minister must
 - (a) be made in writing and submitted to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration via any Consular office of the Government of The Bahamas or at the Consular Division, Ministry of Foreign Affairs located in Nassau;
 - (b) be submitted within thirty days after the aggrieved person is given notice of the decision by the consular officer.
- (3) The Minister may, on review of a decision to refuse an application for the issue of a visa, confirm, vary, or reverse the decision.

8. Power to amend Schedules.

The Minister may from time to time amend all or any of the *Schedules* to these Regulations.

9. Confidentiality of records.

All records relating to the decision of the Minister to grant or refuse an application for a visa are confidential and such records, or information contained in them, shall not be disclosed or provided to third parties except by order of a court of competent jurisdiction within The Commonwealth of The Bahamas.

10. Visa fees.

- (1) An applicant for a visa shall pay the applicable fee set out in the *Fifth Schedule*.
- (2) Visa fees shall be waived for Diplomatic passport holders.

FIRST SCHEDULE (Regulation 3)

CATEGORIES, TYPES AND VALIDITY PERIODS OF VISAS

(A) CATEGORIES OF VISAS

- (1) Tourist Visas issued to persons travelling to The Bahamas for the purpose of leisure.
- (2) Seaman Visas issued to
 - (a) crew members of boats temporarily visiting The Bahamas for the purpose of trade; or
 - (b) employees of cruise ships that are registered vessels of The Bahamas.
- (3) **Diplomatic/Official Visas -** issued to holders of Diplomatic and Official Passports.

(B) TYPES OF VISAS

(1) Single Entry Visa

A single entry visa is valid for one entry only within the time frame of three (3) months and is issued to persons temporarily visiting The Bahamas for pleasure.

(2) Multiple Entry Visa

A multiple entry visa is —

- (a) valid for multiple entries to The Bahamas for periods of three (3) months, six (6) months, one (1) year and three (3) years;
- (b) issued to an individual who is a foreign national requiring a visa to visit The Bahamas who is
 - (i) married to a Bahamian national but not resident in The Bahamas; or
 - (ii) the spouse of a foreign national person legally employed in The Bahamas and who does not reside or intend to reside in the Bahamas.

(C) VISA VALIDITY PERIODS

- (1) Three (3) months for a single entry.
- (2) Three (3) months, six (6) months, one (1) year and three (3) years for multiple entries.
